As Arkansas' Auditor of State, I am pleased to inform you that my Unclaimed Property Division has located [CLAIM AMOUNT] in our database that belongs to you. In about 6-8 weeks from the date of this letter, you will receive a check at the address listed above. No action is required on your part to receive this money.

During the 2025 legislative session, the legislature unanimously approved a bill that allows my office to automatically mail unclaimed property checks to individuals, so long as the value is less than \$5,000. Unclaimed property can be any number of financial items, such as uncashed checks, unreimbursed utility deposits, insurance proceeds, and more. If any of the information is incorrect, please contact my Unclaimed Property Division at 501-682-6000, ext. 2, and reference the Claim ID listed above. We will be unable to forward the check to your new address unless you contact us to update your information.

While I am pleased to have matched you with this property, you may have other unclaimed property in the Great Arkansas Treasure Hunt that was not able to be matched through this initiative. I encourage you and your family members to visit <u>www.claimitar.gov</u> to search for other monies you may have.

My goal as your State Auditor is to return the most money I can back to Arkansans. Since January 2023, I have returned more than \$80 million to current and former residents.
